Tax Disclosure Statement

Beginning January 1, 1994, under new section 6115 of the Internal Revenue Code, a charitable organization must provide a written document disclosure statement to donors who make a payment described as "quid pro quo contributions," in excess of \$75.00. A "quid pro quo" contribution is a payment made partly as a contribution and partly for goods or services provided to the donor by the charity. An example of a "quid pro quo contribution" is when a donor gives a charity \$100 in consideration for a concert ticket valued at \$40. In the example, \$60.00 would be deductible. Because the donor's payment exceeds \$75.00 the disclosure statement must be furnished, even though the deductible amount does not exceed \$75.00. The required written statement must:

- Inform the donor of the amount of the contribution that is deductible for federal income tax purposes which is limited to the excess of any money contributed by the donor over the value of goods and services provided by the charity.
- Provide the donor with a good-faith estimate of the value of the goods or services that the donor received.

The disclosure must be in writing and must be made in a manner that is reasonable and likely to come to the attention of the donor. A penalty is imposed on charities that do not meet the disclosure requirements. Please note that the prevailing basic rule allowing donor deductions, only to the extent that the payment exceeds the fair market value of the goods or services received in return, still applies generally to all quid pro quo contributions. The \$75.00 threshold pertains only to the obligations to disclose, not the rule on deductibility of the payment. Please note that you will receive a statement this evening for each item purchased at the verbal auction. This paid invoice can act as your receipt of acknowledgment of the amount bid for each item. This statement will also include a donor value in which the auction committee and donors have made a "good faith" estimate of the items' fair market value. Please use this information as your means of disclosure. Thank you.

PULL-TAB RAFFLE

- Chances are 6 for \$5. With each chance you get a pull tab
- Open the pull tabs and if you pull a winner, you get the prize assigned to that number
- Prizes range from gift cards to baskets to electronics & more!

Some prizes include wine or beer. The Hall prohibits the consumption of alcohol other than what is sold at the bar. We respectfully request that you honor this rule, and take home unopened any wine or beer that you purchase. Thank you!

VERBAL AUCTION RULES

1. The verbal auction will begin promptly at 8:30pm and will continue until all items have been sold
2. A number and a bidder card have been assigned to you for your bidding convenience. Use of the number is mandatory for bidding
3. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer will be the purchaser. In the event of a dispute, the auctioneer will have the sole and final discretion to either determine the successful bidder or to reoffer and resell the item in dispute
4. Acceptance of your successful bid by the auctioneer is binding
5. Payment by the successful bidder may be made at the end of the auction when all items may be paid for at once. The bank will accept cash, check, Mastercard or VISA
6. PAYMENT IN FULL THIS EVENING IS MANDATORY. The bank will give you a paid receipt
7. ALL SALES ARE FINAL! There will be no exchange or refunds on items by the donors to the HIS KIDS auction except where specified, unless the donor is unable to fulfill the obligation as described. Please do not ask the donors for refunds or exchanges that were not part of the original agreement.
8. The auction committee has endeavored to catalog and describe the items and services correctly, but everything is sold "as is" and is assumed authentic. Certain items and/or services may have restrictive use or other qualifications, which may affect value. Purchasers are bound by the precise restrictions specified by the donors. Please read the specifications and limitations carefully.
9. Values set forth are the donors' estimates and are not warranted by the auction committee for tax purposes or for general value
10. If the auctioneer determines that an opening bid or any subsequent bid is not commensurate with value of the item offered, he may reject the bid and withdraw the item for sale; and if, after having acknowledged an opening bid, he decides thereafter that it is not a sufficient amount, he may reject the bid. The auctioneer reserves the right to announce conditions of sale at any time.

WIPE-OFF BOARD RULES

- All items up for bid are located on tables near respective wipe-off boards
- Bidder gains attention of recording clerk and states the item # he/she wishes to bid on
- Bidder gives his/her bidder number & bid amount to clerk. Clerk records on board
- Bidder returns to board/item as necessary to update their bid
- 5 minutes before each board closes, the clerk will announce that only silent bids are taken. You now have 5 minutes to record your "final bid amount". Once time is up, the clerk will open all final bids and the high bidder wins that item.

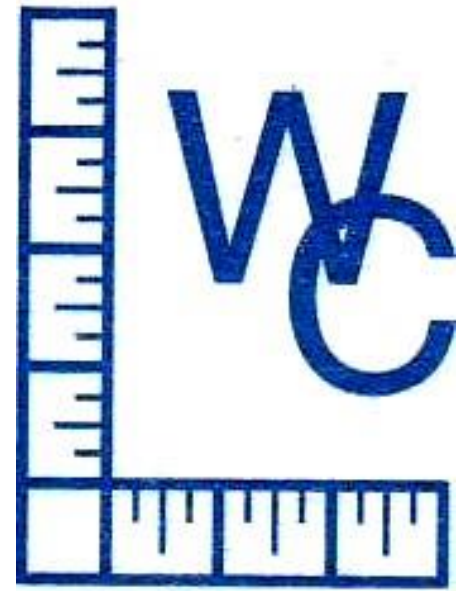
